A. Hardship Variance Appeal ([ZBA-002162-2022](#))

Meadow Avenue, Great Diamond Avenue, Casco Bay Island Holdings, LLC, owner, Tax Map 083A, Block C, Lot 006 and Tax Map 083A, Block H, 003, IR-2 Island Residential Zone: Applicant seeks to merge two noncontiguous lots to meet minimum lot size requirements per section 7.5.3(C)(2). Section 7.5.3(C)(3) requires one lot be put into a conservation easement and meet the 20,000 square foot minimum lot size requirement or the lot of record requirement (section 4.3.1). The owner is requesting a variance from the conservation lot size requirement of section 7.5.3(C)(3) in order to merge the two lots to meet the 20,000 square foot minimum lot area requirement. Representing the owner is Gordon Smith, Esq.
