Order 47-20/21 Appointing Three Members to the 2020 Charter Commission - Sponsored by the 2020 Charter Commission Ad Hoc Committee, Mayor Kate Snyder, Chair

The 2020 Charter Commission met on Friday, August 7, 2020, and voted 4-0 to forward this recommendation to the full City Council for approval.

Michael Kebede, Peter Eglinton, and Dory Waxman are recommended as the three appointed 2020 Charter Commission members.

Pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2103 (B), three of the members of a Charter Commission shall be appointed by the municipal officers of a municipality; in the City of Portland, that is the City Council. The 2020 Charter Commission Ad Hoc Committee met remotely six times over the last week to review 39 applications for the three appointed positions and to interview 20 selected candidates.

Five votes in the affirmative are required for passage after public comment.

Order 48-20/21 Approving the Election of Nine Members to the 2020 Charter Commission - Sponsored by Mayor Kate Snyder

Pursuant to 30-A M.R.S. § 2103 (A)(3), nine of the members of a Charter Commission in Portland may be elected to a charter commission. The exact language is as follows:

"Voter members are elected both at-large and by district or ward, as long as the number of voter members is the same as the number of municipal officers on the board or council of that municipality and the voter members are elected in the same manner as the municipal officers, except that they must be elected without party designation."

This order approves the election of nine members of the 2020 Charter Commission in the manner described above.

Five votes in the affirmative are required for passage after public comment.
