Attendees: Finance Committee Chair Mavodones, Committee Members Costa & Ray, Mayor Snyder, Councilor Chong, City Staff, and Public

Votes Taken (ones which passed are shown in bold):

Amendment Proposal #1 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Passes 3-0

- Add \$75,000 in City Council Legal Services for Charter Commission
- Add \$75,000 for City Council Contractual Services for Racial Equity Steering Committee and Independent Investigation into Police Department

Amendment Proposal #2 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Passes 3-0

- Remove \$12,000 from City Council budget (\$8000 from travel, \$4000 from food)

Amendment Proposal #3 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Passes 2-1 (Mavodones)

- Add 25 cents to the meter rate, adding \$224,900

Amendment Proposal #4 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Fails 1-2 (Costa, Mavodones)

- Add back sustainability associate - \$30,850
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Amendment Proposal #5 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Fails 1-2 (Costa, Mavodones)

- Fund Heritage Tree Ordinance at \$41,000

Amendment Proposal #6 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Fails 1-2 (Costa, Mavodones)

- Maintenance Worker / Groundskeeper - \$57,055

Amendment Proposal #7 (Motion made by Ray, Seconded by Costa) - Passes 2-1 (Mavodones)

- Stipends for Racial Equity Steering Committee - \$7,800

Vote to recommend the FY21 City Manager Recommended Budget to the Full City Council (as amended by the three amendments approved by the Finance Committee - Motion made by Ray Seconded by Costa) – Passes 3-0
