Order 24-21/22 Declaring a Limited Emergency to Continue Remote Public Meetings - Sponsored by Kate Snyder, Mayor

In response to a recent increase in the COVID-19 infection rate, the spread of the Delta variant, and concerns related to less-than-ideal ventilation in meeting venues in City Hall, the City Council will consider declaring a limited emergency to allow for the continuation of remote public meetings in accordance with Maine law and local Remote Participation Policy.

To allow boards and committees to meet remotely as soon as possible, the Council may consider passing this order as an emergency. Seven affirmative votes are required for passage as an emergency after public comment.

6:00 P.M. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS:

The Council will consider suspending the Rules of Procedure for the City Council in order to hold public comment immediately after Order 24-21/22. Seven affirmative votes are required to suspend the Rules after public comment.
