

Questions for Twain Braden to Ask of Vessel Advisory Committee

1. Clarify the grouping of questions by Peaks vs. Down Bay. [Note – a brief examination of the table of contents and the data presentation in the report shows the report very clearly distinguishes Peaks data from Bay Data]
2. What is was the status of the data included in the report dated October 2017 at the time Hank Berg finally made available to the public on February 12, 2019? Why wasn't this data made available sooner after repeated requests by islanders?
3. Why wasn't original survey mailed to homeowners?
4. Will there be additional surveying done to assess public opinion re ferry design (e.g. size, capacity, etc.) and services?
5. Besides public opinion, what other factors (economic, engineering, etc.) factor into vessel design? What are the relative weights of each in the equation?
6. What is the timeline for future Vessel Committee and CBL Board votes on vessel capacity and design?
