4. REPORTS OF DECISIONS AT THE MEETING HELD ON MARCH 22, 2022

- i. Major Site Plan; 94 Portland Street; 94 Portland Street LLC, Applicant. Mazer moved and Smith seconded a motion to approve the site plan with six conditions of approval. Vote 6-0, Silk absent.

5. NEW BUSINESS

- i. Zoning Map and Text Amendment; 2 Riverton Drive; Portland Housing Development Corporation, Applicant. (estimated time 5:30 – 6:30 p.m.) The Planning Board will hold a remote public hearing to consider a zoning map amendment to rezone the R-5 Residential zone bounded by Forest Avenue and Riverside Street into R-5a Residential and B-2 Community Business along with a text amendment to the R-5a Residential zone to allow Places of Assembly as a conditional use. The map amendment also includes the rezoning of the R-5a Residential zone north of Forest Avenue into B-2 Community Business.
- ii. Conditional Use Permit; 11 Pomeroy Street; Chabad Lubavitch of Maine, Applicant. (estimated time 6:30 p.m.) The Planning Board will hold a remote public hearing to consider an after the fact conditional use permit application to facilitate the operation of a place of assembly use within a 900 square foot portion of an existing single-family home at 11 Pomeroy Street. The subject property is 73,281 square feet in size and is located in the R-3 Residential zone. A related minor site plan application, PL-000058-2018, has also been submitted and is under staff review.
