PUBLIC HEARINGS:

Resolve 13-09/10 Appropriating Funds for FY2010 Community Development Block Grant Program, Home Program, and Emergency Shelter Grant Program and Certifications Pertaining Thereto – Sponsored by Joseph E. Gray, Jr., City Manager. Given first public hearing on 3/8/10.

Motion was made by Councilor Anton and seconded by Councilor Donoghue for passage of the City Manager's recommendation. Passage 5-4 (Mavodones, Coyne, Waxman, Skolnik).

Motion was made by Councilor Duson and seconded by Councilor Donoghue to reconsider Resolve 13-09/10. Passage 8-1 (Skolnik). Note: Brings Council back to main motion.

Motion was made by Councilor Marshall and seconded by Councilor Waxman to amend the order by moving \$50,000 from the police department to Learning Works. Failed 4-5 (Leeman, Duson, Donoghue, Anton, Coyne). Motion by Councilor Coyne and seconded by Councilor Skolnik to reconsider this amendment. Passage 6-3 (Leeman, Donoghue, Anton). Passage of amendment 5-4 (Duson, Anton, Donoghue, Leeman).

Motion was made by Councilor Donoghue and seconded by Mayor Mavodones to amend the order by taking \$5,000 from Catherine Day Morrill and moving it to the Peaks Island Workshop. Failed 2-7 (Leeman, Duson, Donoghue, Marshall, Anton, Coyne, Waxman).

Motion was made by Councilor Waxman and seconded by Mayor Mavodones to amend the order by taking \$10,000 each from Cultivating Community and Frannie Peabody and moving it to Amistad. Failed 2-7 (Leeman, Duson, Marshall, Donoghue, Anton, Waxman, Coyne).

Motion was made by Councilor Waxman and seconded by Mayor Mavodones to amend the order to take \$10,000 from Preble Street and moving it to Day One. Failed 2-7 (Leeman, Duson, Marshall, Donoghue, Anton, Coyne, Skolnik).

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Motion was made by Councilor Coyne and seconded by Councilor Waxman to amend the order by using Scenario #1. Failed 3-6 (Mavodones, Leeman, Marshall, Donoghue, Anton, Waxman).

Motion was made by Councilor Duson and seconded by Councilor Coyne to amend the order by deleting funds for Hot Suppa and moving it to Item #3 the Downtown District. Failed 4-5 (Mavodones, Anton, Donoghue, Marshall, Skolnik)

Motion was made by Councilor Marshall and seconded by Councilor Skolnik to amend the order by taking \$20,000 from the Portland Homeless Program and moving it to The Telling Room. Failed 2-7 (Mavodones, Leeman, Duson, Donoghue, Anton, Coyne, Waxman).
