AGENDA ITEM 1 – Meeting Called to Order and Minutes Reviewed:

Meeting was called to order at approximately 5:30PM

Chair Ray moved to accept minutes from previous meeting. The motion was seconded with all in favor.

AGENDA ITEM 2 –Shelter Zoning: Deliberation and vote

The Chair asked Jeff Levine from Planning if he had any updates for the committee – there were no updates at this time.

Highlights: The next step in this process would be the new language for Chapter 14 to be laid out and to list conditional uses. The Chair suggested that once the new language was finalized and put in place that the old language would be removed from Chapter 14.

After further discussion the Chair entertained a motion to send this on to the Planning Board for review. The motion was seconded with all in favor.

AGENDA ITEM 3- Golf cart Ordinance:

Chief Sauschuck addressed the committee and gave an overview of the current ordinance and proposed changes (see back-up materials)

The Chair opened the floor to public comment.

The following individuals spoke on Golf Carts on the islands.

- *Rachel Robbins, Cliff Island; Horns & Flags are not necessary where they don't have roads out there on Cliff; there is no congestion, but agrees education is key & suggested a piece of literature at time of registration, they do not have rental companies; and would like "something" emailed to the islanders*
- *Betty Thompson, Cliff Island; addresses people with children on their laps is a problem on Cliff Island*
- *Lisa, From Peaks Island; addressed concerns on auditory devices, she highlighted concerns that there are times you cannot hear the golf cart coming upon you; the*

carts are just not safe without break lights or turn signals; Lisa also addressed concerns regarding accidents with a number of tourists on Peaks; she like the idea of "common sense" literature, and would like to see consequences for allowing kids to drive

The Chair closed public comment on this item.

The Chair stressed that auditory device has always been a part of the ordinance and the opened the meeting to questions from Councilors.

Councilor Mavodones asked Chief Sauschuck where the ordinance has been in place since the 1990's – What do you do around enforceability? Chief Sauschuck responded with no inspection standards and no current system to putting tail lights on the golf carts enforcement at times is difficult, educating the public is key. Mike Murray who is from the city Island/Neighborhood Administrator suggested a signed letter from the chief's at time of registration addressing any changes. Councilor Batson suggested to list the consequences to give more of an impact to grab people's attention.

Councilor Mavodones asked committee & staff if anyone knew how many registrations there are for the islands? Mike Murray will follow-up with the committee.

The Chair thanked the committee, staff & public and reminded everyone to come back to the May 9th meeting. At the May 9th meeting there will be another opportunity for public comment. The committee will then have committee deliberation and a vote on any needed changes and if ready, will be sent it to the full council to consider the recommended changes.

Community Policing Update:

Chief Sauschuck addressed the committee and provided an overview (see back-up materials) include:

- Bayside represents less than 1% of City's landmass and only 5% of its population
- This neighborhood accounted for more than 21% of all the police calls for service in the first 10 months of 2016 (34% of all public disorder calls for service originated in Bayside)
- Calls to Bayside have increased 71%
- Bayside currently patrolled by a single beat officer who must respond to calls ranging from burglar alarms and motor vehicles accidents and robberies.

AGENDA ITEM 5- Noise Ordinance: Public Hearing on Noise Ordinance

Public Comment Open at this time:

- *Denine Leeman, East Brown Cow - worked with engineers whom conducted a sound study for the Hyatt Place she described that the noise ordinance has exploded – the study showed readings of .92 Decibels and the city ordinance states shall not exceed .55 decibels for district B3*
- *Kathy- Ocean Ave, also works for Street Co. on Fore Street – she stated Fore Street is one of the loudest streets down in the Old Port. Bars will turn up their music and they like to see who can be louder; speakers are now outside*
- *George- Bayside- noise is treated differently from different areas, 100's of people gather in the shelter areas and cause just as much noise and other problems.*
- *Dana Street, Portland –owner Street Co., the night life in the Wharf Street area has changed in recent years where bars have developed louder music to draw more people*

in (live bands etc) the noise level is harder to measure, the meter readings at times can be all over the place, it isn't always just the number for total volume. Many nights they have to continually go over to the other business to keep asking them to turn down the music because they can't have a normal conversation inside his business.

- *Tim – Hyatt Hotel, other cities don't have a problem managing noise. Enforcement, or lack of, shouldn't be an issue; Tim stated he is concerned as to how this reflects on our city.*

Public Comment on Noise Ordinance closed at this time

Andy Downs from Park & Recreation mentions he can research best practices from other cities such as Burlington & Boston where they had similar issues. Also, the Sound Oversight Committee, being re-established, would like to look at more funds to establish a baseline for five different sites.

Councilor Mavodones felt that .55 decibels is unrealistic and .92 is too high and requests that the data be looked at from the last 3-5 years. Also, would like to know what other cities may have conducted similar noise level studies, lessons learned and what action may have been taken.

Chair Ray would like to explore the ordinance requests and prepare for June's meeting:

Guiding questions:

- What area would this noise monitor sites apply to?
- Do we do different levels for different areas?
- Outdoor speakers, clean-up ordinance (consolidate info)
- What scale do we use? Refer back to Mike Russell's handout from March meeting
- How to enforce? (Chief Sauschuck to follow-up with City Manager)

With no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:30

Proposed Amendments to the Golf Cart Ordinance

May 2017

Sec. 28-1. Definitions.

The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them below. When a term is used in this chapter but not defined below, the definitions in 29-A M.R.S. §101 and any amendments thereto shall be used.

Motor vehicle shall mean any self-propelled vehicle, including a golf cart registered by the city for island use, not operated exclusively on tracks but does not include: (a) A snowmobile as defined herein; (b) An all-terrain vehicle as defined in article V; or (c) A motorized wheelchair.

Operate shall mean to operate, drive, or use a vehicle in any manner, whether or not the vehicle is moving.

Sec. 28-185. Golf carts on certain island streets by certain persons. The operation of golf carts shall be permitted on the streets of Portland's islands Cliff Island, Great Diamond Island and Peaks Island if in compliance with the following requirements:

(a) The operator must be over the age of twenty-one (21) or possess a valid license to operate a motor vehicle;

(b) Such golf carts shall be operated only in daylight, not earlier than one-half hour before sunrise and not later than one-half hour after sundown; unless equipped with and utilizing suitable headlights and taillights as determined by the police department; shall keep to the extreme right of the roadway; shall not exceed a speed of twenty ten (20) miles per hour; and shall obey all traffic laws applicable to motor vehicles;

(c) When in use at nighttime or at other times when motor vehicles are required to display headlights, an electric personal assistive mobility device or golf cart must have:

1. A lit front light that emits a white light visible from a distance of at least 200 feet to the front;
2. A red reflector to the rear that is visible at least 200 feet to the rear; and
3. A 12-inch reflector strip or visibility tape prominently displayed on both the driver's and passenger's side of the cart.

(d) Each golf cart shall be equipped with an auditory warning device, a visual safety flag on a whip antenna of at least six (6) feet in height or visibility tape; slow vehicle markings; and display a sticker on the cart showing annual registration with the city treasury division as an island vehicle.

(e) While the golf cart is in motion, the driver and every passenger in a golf cart must be seated in a seat designed to hold passengers. No person may stand up or ride in the lap of the driver and/or other passenger of a golf cart while it is moving.

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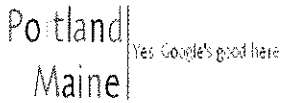

Hello Ms. Ray,

I am writing you about Peaks Island golf carts.

My issue with them has to do with their unregulated emissions. Golf carts weren't required by the EPA until recently to have pollution control devices on them. The gasoline golf carts also frequently have poor muffler systems and can be quite noisy. The island doesn't appear to have many golf carts with pollution controls.

Unfortunately, in the Summer, the rental gasoline powered golf carts are in heavy use. This puts 25 or so rental carts buzzing the island. And most unfortunately, the buzzing carts produce noxious clouds of exhaust. Last Summer, I was literally bathed in fumes every time I walked around the island. It was really quite unpleasant.

May I suggest you visit and take a walk around the island and experience the unpleasantness of the air pollution? I think you would be appalled. It is hard to be a 'crown jewel' of the city when the pollution is so intense.

I am not against the rental golf carts per se. But, I do object highly to the fumes. The privately owned gasoline powered golf carts, while causing a similar problem, at least aren't on the road constantly. The island tour business uses electric powered golf carts.

I have heard from Mary Anne Mitchell that you are a member of a committee considering changes to the golf cart regulations. My request is that you consider banning the introduction of new-to-the-island gasoline powered golf carts and allow electric drive vehicles only. Perhaps the existing gas powered carts can be phased out over a period of years or left to simply expire on their own.

Thank you for considering this.

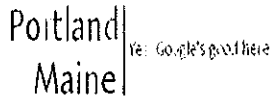

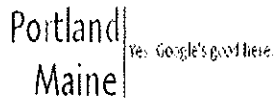

I am writing to all to express my disappointment in the proposed Golf Cart ordinance.

I am not talking about underage drivers, I am talking about children who are held in lap by an adult while driving or as passengers. Also unrestrained small children, who's feet cannot touch the floor to brace themselves while seated. Small children and babies have no business in the front seat unrestrained.

It is proven that unrestrained children are not protected in a head on collision, or hard braking scenario, and can be injured, even at 20 MPH in a passenger vehicle, which is why Maine law was established on this. Even worse, children held in one's arms, either while driving or while in the arms of a front seat passenger, is a terrible "airbag protection" for that person holding them.

We Islanders have seen this scenario many times, and cringe when we see it. I cannot tell you how many times I speak to these offenders about this, and shake my head when they still say *they* are good drivers or they have no better way to drive.

So why do passenger vehicles only with Island stickers still have seat belt and child seat & safety laws that have to be followed? **Because it makes sense.**

I think this "children in front seats of Golf Carts" needs to be addressed more thoroughly.

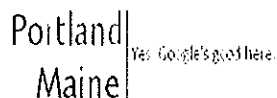

Dear Mr. Murray,

I have just reviewed the proposed Peaks Island Golf Carts Ordinance. I have a particular interest as I am the manager of Peaks Island Golf Carts. I am unable to attend the workshop, so here are some comments.

The proposal shouldn't cause undue hardship in most areas. The idea that golf carts with roofs might need a flag is a little wacky, as those carts are taller than most cars and some SUV's, so it's not like they are not noticeable. But most of our carts have reflective tape on them, so it's not a problem.

My concern is about signaling devices, i.e horns etc. Have there been instances where somebody didn't hear a golf cart coming? I doubt it. Is it easy for a driver or passenger to alert somebody vocally? Of course. More importantly, do people on the back shore and other neighborhoods of the island want to hear the additional noise of people beeping, honking, dinging, or otherwise making noise as they make their merry way about the island?

Never mind the fact that it's a financial burden for the business in terms of procurement and maintenance. It's a solution in search of a problem. I have never heard an islander say, "Boy, I sure wish those golf carts had a way of making more noise." I have never heard of an instance where a lack of a signaling device caused a safety issue. The only safety issue regarding signaling devices I have run across is people ignoring the vehicle in reverse signal.

I think the requirement for signaling devices is unnecessary, and will have the unintended consequence of making the island noisier.

Everything else on the list is something that we always tell our customers before they leave in one of our carts, with one exception: animals. Some of the people who rent carts do so because of mobility issues, and some have service or other companion animals. We always tell people to keep control of their dogs. It's a restriction that is not applied to automobile drivers out here, so it seems unfair to restrict golf cart owners or renters from having an animal aboard. A dog in a lap is far more controllable than a dog seated next to the owner or on the floor, unless it's a St. Bernard or something.

Safe Bars Portland

Safe Bars Portland is a coalition of organizations and businesses working to bring the Safe Bars program to Portland to improve safety in drinking establishments and increase training opportunities for those employed in the hospitality industry.

Safe Bars (<http://safebars.org/>) uses innovative bystander intervention strategies to train bar staff to recognize and safely address sexual aggression in their establishments. Following training, participating establishments receive the Safe Bar logo decal to display at their entrance, on their website and social media, a six month follow-up, and are promoted through the Safe Bars website. Safe Bars has grown exponentially in Washington DC over the past 3 years, receiving very positive reviews from participants and bar patrons as well as extensive press:

In Spring 2017, Safe Bars DC will come to Maine to train the members of the coalition to lead the initiative going forward. Safe Bars Portland will launch in May 2017 with 2-hour bar training sessions for bar staff offered on a sliding scale based on business size and free workshops and events for patrons.

Safe Bars Portland is seeking support for start-up costs including bringing Safe Bars DC to Maine to lead training, acquire materials, and free promotional training. The estimated overall cost of the launch is \$7,500 of which \$5,000 is training.
